



IN CASE OF HAZARDOUS WEATHER

If Seattle Public Schools are CLOSED due to snow or other hazardous weather, The Children's Center at Burke Gilman Gardens will also be CLOSED.

Hazardous Weather during School Breaks:

If hazardous weather occurs during Seattle Public Schools Winter Breaks or other non-school days, be sure to call the Center after 6:00 a.m. for closure information. Many of our staff members live outside of Seattle, and are unable to commute during snow or other hazardous weather. In order for our program to remain open, we must be able to maintain state licensing ratio requirements at all times, so closures are determined by the road conditions and the number of staff members that can safely commute to/from the Center.

Late Starts:

If Seattle Public Schools are open 1 or 2 hours late, the Center will open late as well. The time will be determined by the weather and road conditions, and there will be a message with the opening time recorded on our voicemail by 6:00 a.m.

Early Closures/Power Outages:

If hazardous weather occurs during the day, families will be called to pick up their children and the Center will close early. If the Center loses electricity or water for any reason, we are required to close asap.

IN ALL CASES, WE WILL HAVE A MESSAGE WITH CLOSURE INFORMATION RECORDED ON OUR VOICEMAIL BY 6:00 A.M. PLEASE BE SURE TO CALL BEFORE BRINGING YOUR CHILD(REN) TO THE CENTER IN THE MORNING.

Closures are an inconvenience for all of us, but please remember that the safety of our staff members and families is of the utmost importance to us-- we greatly appreciate your understanding!
